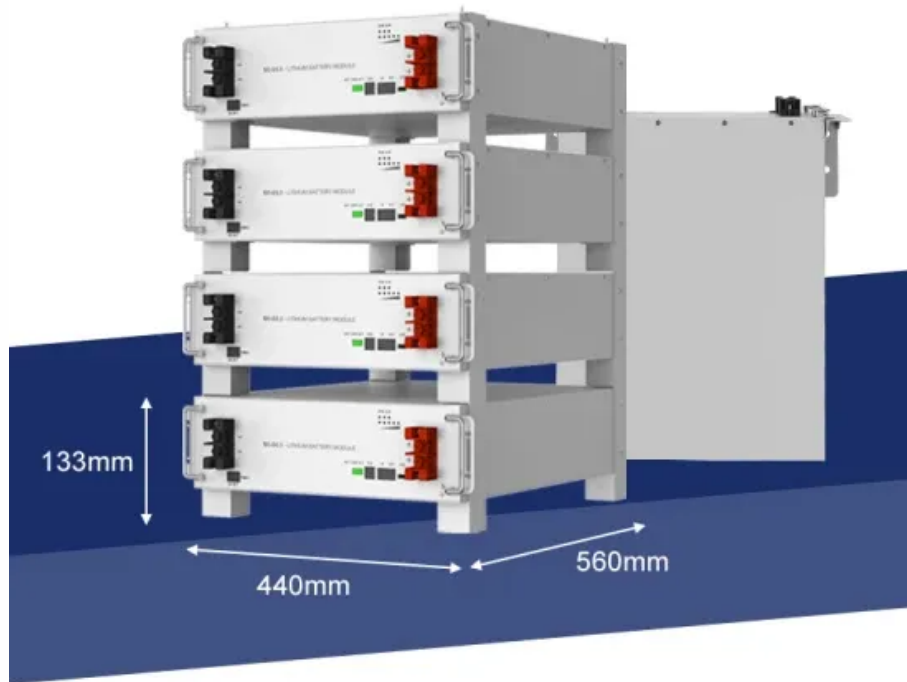


Early Outdoor Power Supply
