END OF LIFE CONSIDERATIONS FOR BESS

While some non-battery BESS components may have longer service lives or resale value, battery management remains the dominant driver of end-of-life cost. Developers may design BESS

BESS Incidents

It may be appropriate to design BESS containers with tethered wall and/or roof explosion relief panels that are sized to release to the outside at pressures well below those that might cause any structural

END-OF-LIFE CONSIDERATIONS FOR STATIONARY ENERGY

Some BESS components (e.g., transformers) have a much longer lifespan than batteries and can thus be reused. Alternatively, a BESS developer may design the system to last 25-35 years and replace
