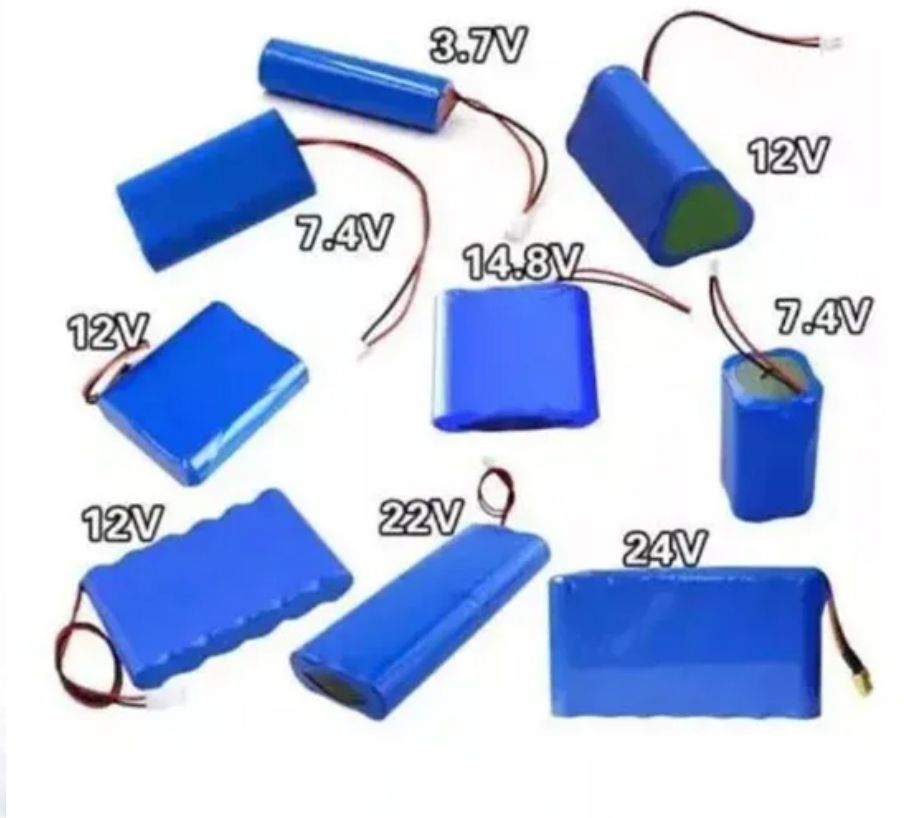

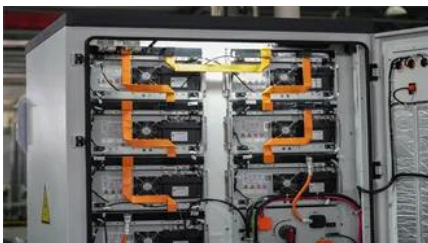


"More likely than not"
